- Report from the Real Estate Search Committee and Marketing Company
- 2. Report from the Financial Review Committee
- Reading of a Resolution on a pending real estate offer for Omar Shrine Property in Mt. Pleasant, South Carolina

ARTICLE 34

Temple Business Affairs and Fiscal Regulations

§ 334.9 Sale of Temple Assets. Any temple, or any of its affiliates, contemplating the sale, lease, exchange, mortgage, pledge or other disposition of all or substantially all of its property and assets, may only do so upon such terms and conditions and for such consideration as shall be first authorized by a vote of the temple at a stated or special meeting which sets forth in the notice of the meeting the specific nature of the business to be transacted. The notice of the meeting must be sent to every member of the temple at least 20 days prior to the meeting. Amend. 1986, 2011

§ 334.10 Temple Holding Corporation.

(a) **Existing.** Any temple now incorporated pursuant to a state statute which authorizes the formation of a fraternal corporation, not for profit, deriving its rights and powers from a Grand or Imperial body, and any affiliated organization incorporated pursuant to a not-for-profit statute, may continue its corporate existence so long as its charter or bylaws contain provisions that the corporation (1) yields obedience to Shrine law; (2) exists solely as a nonprofit corporation having no purpose other than that of acquiring, owning, selling, or otherwise disposing of, and mortgaging real estate, and the erection, maintenance and operation of buildings thereon, for its own use; (3) no part of its assets or funds shall inure to the benefit of individuals personally except in payment for services actually rendered or performed; and (4) in the event of dissolution, the assets and funds remaining after the payment of all debts of the corporation shall be conveyed to the temple or Shriners Hospitals for Children. Amend. 1996

Nobles,

Some of you may not know why we are researching real estate ideas to resolve Omar Temples financial condition. Last year, 2019, at the Organizational meeting, the Divan began explaining and revealing the financial status of Omar Shrine. Several meetings were held disclosing the financial deficit that declining membership/dues and excessive overhead were producing. This information was provided to be informative and transparent, so the Nobility would be part of the solution.

Omar's dues, revenue generated from building rentals, leases, and fundraising, all support our Mt. Pleasant building, fraternal office, office staff, and fraternal budget. Unfortunately, our declining membership does not provide its financial portion, along with building rentals, leases, and fundraising, to support Omar's overhead. Therefore, resulting in savings dilution.

Building rentals and leases are intended to provide revenue to help support Omar's Mt. Pleasant property, office, office staff, and fraternity. Unfortunately, through recent years, it has not provided our fraternity enough revenue to offset Omar's declining membership dues.

Your first suggested solution was to increase Omar's dues. Omar's dues have not been increased in approximately 20 years. The amount of \$79.00 that the Nobility pays is misleading; \$35.00 of the total is designated for Shriners International. Omar is assessed \$30.00 for each member by Shriners International and \$5.00 is collected for the Shriners Hospitals for Children. This leaves Omar with \$44.00, but \$14.00 is designated for Building and Maintenance. The remaining \$30.00, is your dues portion that helps to cover the cost of Omar's operations. After much discussion, we were met with much resistance to a proposed dues increase. Also, the Nobility asked us to provide leadership.

Your latest suggested solution was to downsize. You asked that we obtain an appraisal of the Omar property in Mt. Pleasant and evaluate selling to obtain an affordable option. To date, an appraisal of the Omar property has been completed. The appraised value of the property is \$8.7 million. Then, an Advisement Committee was formed and given the task of reviewing the appraisal and looking at options. The Advisement Committee returned with the recommendation to sell the property. After much discussion, the Divan decided to move forward with this recommendation. The first step was for the Divan to vote on whether to sell the property; the motion to sell the property was approved. Although the Divan voted to sell, it does not mean that the property will be sold. The Nobility has to approve any sale of the Omar Shrine property. If the Nobility authorizes the sale, approval must be secured from Shriners International. The next step for the Divan was to find a commercial realtor to market the property. The Advisement Committee researched the available commercial realtors in our area; their recommendation was to utilize the firm; CBRE of Charleston. The Omar Shrine property at 176 Patriots Point went on the market in April. A call for bids was performed and seven (7) bids were received. The Divan, with the recommendation of Mr. Charles Carmody of CBRE, selected the best bid of those submitted.

This brings us to the Stated Meeting on July 31, 2021. At this meeting, the Nobility will be presented with 1) Report from the Real Estate Search Committee and marketing company, 2) Report of the Financial Review Committee, and 3) Reading of the Resolution to Sell the Omar Shrine property located in Mt. Pleasant. There will be a question/answer session. No other business will be discussed at this meeting.

Another meeting will be held, at which time the Nobility will vote on the previously read and discussed resolution to sell the Omar Shrine property located in Mt. Pleasant.

I hope this information has been informative.


