Ramblings from the Recorder

Nobles,

It has been a busy Summer for Omar!! In July, your Divan attended the Imperial Session in Houston, TX. There were several significant changes proposed to the Imperial Bylaws that were all defeated. The first of these was the proposal to eliminate the prerequisite of being a Mason to become a Shriner. The supporters of this change believe that our membership would

increase significantly without this prerequisite. Being a Mason is a part of the foundation of our Fraternity as Nobles, it is our brand, it is what makes us different from other fraternal organizations. The second significant bylaw change proposal was to form a Virtual Temple through Shriners International. An individual could become a Shriner through Shriners International without any ties to an actual Temple. If this occurred, they would not be supporting the local Temples, Clubs, and Units; but they would be a Shriner. The last bylaw change that I will cover was the proposal to increase the per Capita that we pay to Shriners International. They purposed increasing this by \$20 per member. We pay \$30 per member currently from your annual dues. If this had passed, it would have been effective immediately; this would have left Omar with only \$10 per member to operate the Omar Temple office.

On September 11, we had a Special meeting regarding the possibility of the sale of the property at 176 Patriots Point. The Nobility spoke loud and clear, by a vote of 185 – 69, no sale. What does this mean for Omar? We, the Divan, and our Nobility must work together to produce a solution of our financial difficulties. We must act quickly, but prudently, developing a plan for now and the future. If we work together as a team, we can give Omar a stable, financial future.

We had a great Charlie Miller Golf Tournament with a record number of teams participating; Noble John Murphy and his committee did an excellent job. Kudos to Oriental Guide Kevin Wadford, who worked is a** off to make the first Omar Sports Banquet a total success!!

Omar was well represented at SASA with several, several of our units bringing home trophies from the parade!! There was a large crowd on non-Shriners enjoying the parade. If you were not able to attend this year, make plans to come next fall.

A Stated Meeting of Omar Shriners will be held at Omar Shrine, 176 Patriots Point, Mt. Pleasant, South Carolina on Thursday, December 3rd, 2021 at six o'clock in the evening for passing on petitions for membership and any other business that may rightly be brought before the assembly. Petitions for membership acted on at this meeting and candidates elected will be eligible for initiation at the Homecoming Ceremonial, December 4th through 6th, 2021.

Article 23: Temple Membership

323.5 Balloting

Favorable: Subsequent to a report on a candidate's petition, paper ballots shall be distributed, marked, collected and counted in the presence of the Nobility. If a majority of the ballots are favorable, the candidate is elected to temple membership subject to initiation. If a majority of the ballots are unfavorable or if the votes are evenly divided, the candidate is rejected. The presiding officer may call for a collective ballot.

- (a) Written Objection: A written objection, signed by at lease three members of the temple in good standing, presented to the Potentate or Recorder prior to the time balloting is commenced, has the same effect as an adverse ballot.
- (b) Written Objection Deadline: In temples where written notice of all candidate's petitions has been mailed to the members, not less than one week before the date set for balloting, any written objection provided for in the subsection (b) must be received by the Potentate or Recorder at least 48 hours before the time specified in the notice for balloting.
- (c) Finality: After the balloting is completed and the candidates are declared elected and notified, no objection made thereafter with respect to the candidates may be considered unless ordered by vote of the temple.
- (d) Reapplication: A rejected candidate may not apply again for 13 weeks.

SUBJECT: Positive Uplifting Ceremonials

The Shrine Directors Association's role is probably more important today than it has been at any time over the last 25 years, as there are more challenges today in attracting new members than ever before.

We recently met with the leaders of the Shrine Directors Association regarding concerns about hazing. It is vital for all Nobles to understand that <u>ANY</u> type of hazing; <u>physical hazing</u>, <u>mental hazing or any</u> activity causing any member public embarrassment violates both state and Shrine law.


The Shrine Directors Association will continue their ongoing efforts to exclude improper hazing activities and/or stunts. They will also promote the Arch Degree, the Knickerbocker Degree, team building, and new and unique activities to all of the events surrounding the creation of a new Noble, including the participation of his family. As we bring new and younger members into the Shrine with the hope and expectation that they will involve their families in our activities, it becomes even more important that the ceremonial experience is positive, uplifting, and memorable.

We encourage all temples to embrace the Association's efforts for encouraging the newly created Nobles to immediately become enthusiastic and engaged. We also believe that by providing a new and positive ceremonial experience, temples will abandon "hazing practices and/or stunts" that are actually prohibited by law in the vast majority of states.

While the Shrine Directors Association continues to work to strongly discourage the practice of hazing, they do not have the power or authority to impose discipline or to otherwise prohibit the practice at each temple. Therefore, the Imperial Divan will stand shoulder to shoulder with the Shrine Directors Association's efforts to properly enforce the prohibition upon such practices.

Notice of Stated Meeting and Election of Officers



Be it known that a Regular Stated Meeting of Omar Shriners is called for the purpose of electing officers for the year 2022 and any business that may rightly come before the membership.

The meeting will be held on Saturday, January 8th, 2022 at 176 Patriots Point, Mt. Pleasant, South Carolina. The Stated Meeting and Elections will begin promptly at 10:00 AM. A current 2022 Dues Card is required for admission.

Officers to be elected:

Potentate, Chief Rabban, Assistant Rabban, High Priest and Prophet, Oriental Guide, Treasurer, Recorder, Four (4) Representatives to Shriners International, Two (2) Representatives to South Atlantic Shrine Association (SASA).

Electioneering: A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine Temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office a resume consisting of his educational background, vocational history and his masonic and shrine record, except as provided by the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices by a noble or a group of nobles suggesting, recommending, opposing or containing the name of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited. For violation of the above, the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending nobble and he may declare the election of officers void and order a new election.

This notice of annual meeting and election is being sent to each member of Omar Shriners as directed by the Recorder of Omar Shriners.
