2018 HOMECOMING CEREMONIAL NOVEMBER 29-DECEMBER 2, 2018 MT. PLEASANT, SC

A stated meeting of Omar Shriners will be held at Omar Shrine Center, 176 Patriots Point, Mt. Pleasant, South Carolina at six o'clock on Thursday, November 29th, 2018 for passing on petitions for membership, voting on a property easement for temple property owned at 176 Patriots Point, Mt. Pleasant, South Carolina and any other general business that may come before the membership.

Petitions for membership acted on at this meeting and candidates elected will be initiated on Friday and Saturday, November 30th and December 1st.

Article 23: Temple Membership 323.5 Balloting

- (A) Favorable: Subsequent to a report on a candidate's petition, paper ballots shall be distributed, marked, collected and counted in the presence of the Nobility. If a majority of the ballots are favorable, the candidate is elected to temple membership subject to initiation. If a majority of the ballots are unfavorable or if the votes are evenly divided, the candidate is rejected. The presiding officer may call for a collective ballot.
- Written Objection: A written objection, signed by at lease 3 members of the temple in good standing, presented to **(B)** the Potentate or the Recorder prior to the time balloting is commenced, has the same effect as an adverse ballot.
- Written Objection Deadline: In temples where, notice of all candidates' petitions has been mailed to the members (C) not less than one week before the date set for the balloting, any written objection provided for in the subsection(b) must be received by the Potentate or Recorder at least 48 hours before the time specified in the notice for balloting.
- Finality: After the balloting is completed and the candidates are declared elected and notified, no (D) objection made thereafter with respect to the candidates may be considered unless ordered by the vote of the temple.
- **Reapplication:** A rejected candidate may not apply again for 13 weeks. **(E)**



NOTICE OF OMAR SHRINERS' ANNUAL STATED MEETING AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS FOR 2019



Be it known that a *Regular Stated Meeting* of Omar Shriners is called for the purpose of electing officers for the year 2019 and any business that may rightly come before the membership. The meeting will be held on Saturday, January 12, 2019 at 176 Patriots Point, Mt. Pleasant, South Carolina. The Stated Meeting and Elections will begin promptly at 10:00 AM with coffee and doughnuts being served prior to in the lobby from 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM.

A current 2019 Dues Card is required for admission.

Officers to be elected: Potentate, Chief Rabban, Assistant Rabban, High Priest and Prophet, Oriental Guide, Treasurer, Recorder, Four (4) Representatives to Shriners International, Two (2) Representatives to South Atlantic Shrine Association (SASA).

Electioneering: A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine Temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office a resume consisting of his educational background, vocational history and his masonic and shrine record, except as provided by the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices by a noble or a group of nobles suggesting, recommending, opposing or containing the name of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.

The expenditure of money for gifts, favors or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited. For violation of the above, the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending nobble and he may declare the election of officers void and order a new election. This notice of annual meeting and election is being mailed to each member of Omar Shriners as directed by the Recorder of Omar Shriners.

Notes from the Chief Rabban


