This Potentate had the distinct Honor of giving the nomination speech to elect our Imperial Officer – Imperial Sir Kenny Craven to the next position in the Imperial line (Imperial Oriental Guide). He will be the Imperial Potentate in the year 2022 – 2023.

Here is some legislation that was passed at the Imperial Shrine Session that you the Nobility need to know. This legislation reads as follows: “The Board of Governors of the Twin Cities Hospital and the Boards of Directors and Trustees of Shrine Hospitals for Children would be authorized to reach a decision on relocating the Twin Cities Shriners Hospital”. This legislation also passed for the Cincinnati Shrine Hospital, and the Tampa Shrine Hospital.

The other piece of legislation that Failed reads as follows: “The Boston Shriners Hospital is requesting that a moratorium be placed on any changes in location or in services currently provided at Boston Shriners Hospital while negotiations occur with Massachusetts General Hospital”. Both pieces of these legislations are important to you the Nobility and you should know the future of our Shrine Hospitals and direction that they will be taking.

This year for the first time in the history of the Shrine your representatives voted using electronic devices and not the old way of paper balloting. We had both type paper ballot and electronic ballot but primarily used the electronic devices, which took less time for the results. Your Imperial Shrine has now moved into the 21st century. This will be an added plus making the voting (balloting) to help speed up the process for the tallying of the vote (ballot).

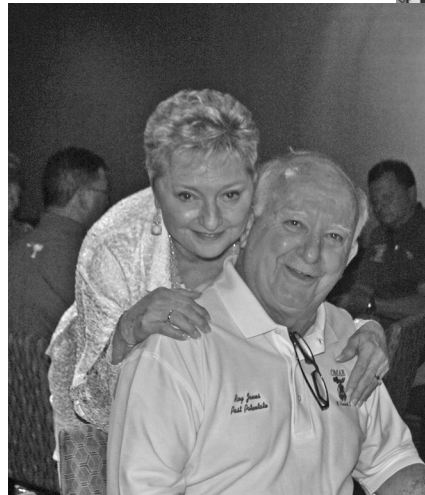
