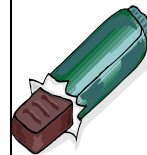

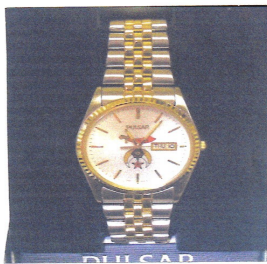

Pleasant, SC, Saturday, January 14th, 2012 commencing at 10:00 a.m. A current dues card is required for admission to the Annual Meeting.

**IMPERIAL COUCNIL BY-LAWS REQUIRE THAT THE FOLLOWING EXTRACT FROM ARTICLE 25 BE PUBLISHED
IN THE NOTICE AND SENT TO THE MEMBERSHIP:**

The first seven officers of the Temple are the Potentate, Chief Rabban, Assistant Rabban, High Priest and Prophet, Oriental Guide, Treasurer and Recorder.

325.2 The first seven officers shall be elected annually by ballot and constitute the official Divan. Candidates for elective office in a Temple must be members in good standing of that Temple.

325.4 Each Temple must elect its Officers and Representatives at its annual meeting in January.

325.5 Election of officers shall be by separate written ballot and by a majority vote of those present and voting. A blanket ballot is prohibited.

325.6 Nominations must commence not later than 9:00 p.m. and when that hour arrives all other business must cease and none may be transacted until the election is concluded.

325.8 Candidates for office and representatives must be placed in nomination from the floor. Nominating committees are prohibited.

325.9 (a) Where a Temple elects more than one Representative; all candidates must be balloted for on one written ballot.

(b) Each member voting must vote only for the total number of representatives to be elected, otherwise his ballot cannot be counted as a vote.

(c) A majority vote of those present and voting is necessary to elect each representative.

(d) Only those candidates who receive a majority vote shall be declared elected.

(e) Successive written ballots must then be taken in the same manner on other candidates until all Representatives are elected.

(f) If more candidates receive a majority vote than the number of Representatives to be elected, then those receiving the greatest number of votes shall be declared elected.

(g) Blank ballots are not votes

325.10(a) The printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets or other devices by a Noble, suggesting, recommending, opposing or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the Temple is prohibited.

(b) For any violation of (1), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.

(c) At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election the Temple Recorder shall mail each member a notice thereof containing this section.
