Stated Meeting of Omar Temple

A stated meeting of Omar Temple will be held at 176 Patriots Point, Mt. Pleasant, S.C. at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, November 10, 2010 for the purpose of passing on petitions for membership and any other business properly appearing. Petitions for membership acted on at this meeting and candidates elected will be initiated at the Homecoming Ceremonial in Mt. Pleasant, S.C., November 13, 2010 at 1:00 P.M.

323.5 Balloting

- 1) Subsequent to a report on a candidate's petition, the ballot is passed and if less than 3 black balls appear; he is elected.
- 2) If the ballot reveals 4 or more black balls, the candidate is rejected. If the ballot reveals 3 black balls, another ballot is passed immediately. If 3 black balls appear a second time, the candidate is rejected.
- 3) A written objection, signed by at least 3 members of the Temple in good standing, presented to the Potentate or the Recorder prior to the time balloting is commenced has the same effect as an adverse ballot.
- 4) In temples where written notice of all candidates' petitions have been mailed to the members not less than one week before the date set for balloting, any written objection provided for the subsection (3) must be received by the Potentate or Recorder at least 48 hours before the time specified in the notice for balloting.
- 5) After the balloting is completed and the candidates are declared elected and notified, no objection made thereafter with respect to the candidates may be considered unless ordered by vote of the Temple.
- 6) A rejected candidate may not apply again for 13 weeks
